- ◆ *Where do I have to travel to join these trips?*
 - You will meet the rest of the group in the Ladysmith, WI, area and travel is provided from there to where the canoe trip will begin. After getting off the water, transportation will be arranged for returning to the mission house for the trip wrap-up.
- ◆ *How much will this experience cost?*
 - There is a non-refundable application fee of \$250 with an additional \$500 due the day you leave on the trip. Returning students receive a \$50 discount, and an additional \$50 off for bringing a friend.

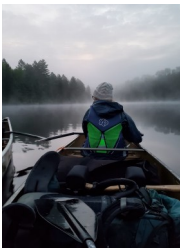
